





### **GPLD Phase 2, Silvertown**

#### **CLIENT: GLP**



One of our largest and complex industrial demolition projects to date, with high reach demolition at 35m. Despite the constraints and logistic requirements, the demolition phase of this project was completed safely, on time and on budget.

This project, located alongside the River Thames at London Docklands, included the demolition of over 20 industrial buildings varying in size and construction, the largest being 35m+. Working closely with LUL/TFL regarding asset protection of their overhead DLR and the protection of the River Thames, including the adjacent operational neighbouring businesses.

In addition, An extensive internal strip out operation preceded the demolition works which included the removal of nonlicensable and licensable asbestos materials. There were also industrial areas which contained pipe gantries and processing plant and tanks that were removed.

### The Base, Crawley

One of our large industrial demolition projects of the former Virgin Atlantic The Base training centre, which covered 20619m<sup>2</sup> of the total 4.2 hectre site.

Located within the heart of Crawley's industrial area, the 3-storey warehouse building was formed of steel frame, brick and composite cladding with flat roods, concrete floors and as imagined, was heavily serviced.

The works comprised of the complete internal strip out, asbestos removal, mechanical demolition of the existing buildings and structures, lift slabs and foundations across the site, crush the arisings and cut and fill operations to formation level for a complete package solution for our client.

### The Landing, Maidenhead

**CLIENT: MCALEER & RUSHE** 

A large commercial/residential mixed use demolition project with logistic constraints located in the heart of Maidenhead town centre for The Landing redevelopment project.

The triangle formed by King Street, Queen Street & Broadway involved the demolition of a mixture of building type along its perimeter. A number of 1960's and 1980's buildings provided retail and office space with residential properties.

In addition, an extensive internal strip out operation preceded the demolition works which included the removal of nonlicensable and licensable asbestos materials. There were also areas that required protective scaffold structures, and temporary works, demolition of a fire damaged public house, construction of a temporary car park, lifting slabs and foundations across the site and crushing arisings to cut & fill to formation levels and pile mat.

#### Small and fairly straight-forward demolition project with an extensive cut & fill earthworks operation across Horsham farm land.

The site was formally of mixed use, a former civil engineering contractors depot and motor salvage yard, with a substantial amount of greenfield space.

This project required the internal strip out and mechanical demolition of all buildings, followed by a large cut & fill exercise across the site, including:

- Compacted Layering to specification
- Detailed soil and layer testing and reporting
- Fill performance and reporting
- Bat house construction for relocation of species in accordance with Ecology specialists
